EPACRIS IMPRESSA - common heath (white or pink)

HOVEA HETEROPHYLLA - common hovea.

GOODENIA OVATA - hop goodenia.

BILLARDIERA SCANDENS - common apple berry.

TETRATHECA CILIATA - pinkeye

DROSERA DELATA SSP *AURICULATA* - pale sundew.

DICTYOGON STRICTUS - chocolate lily

BURCHARDIA UMBELLATA - milkmaids

CREEPERS

CLEMATIS ARISTATA - Austral clematis

HARDENBERGIA VIOACEA - purple coral pea.

ORCHIDS

PTEROSTYLIS NUTANS - nodding greenhood.

DIURIS MACULATA - leopard orchid

(growing along creek bank).
